NZD - A Deeper Easing Cycle, Priced

Rate Cut Well Within Expectations, But A Larger 50bps Was Considered

RBNZ took OCR down by 25bps to 3.00%, in line with expectations (including ourselves). What surprised was the dovish statement and the fact that a larger 50bps cut was debated. The board was rather divided with a 4-2 vote landing on the smaller 25bps cut as final decision. Interim RBNZ Governor Hawkesby said that data will determine the pace of the monetary policy easing but all meetings are “live”. We look for NZD to remain on the backfoot against the USD but retracement (higher) against the AUD is likely in the near-term.

Recovery Has Been Languid

There is still “significant spare capacity”. Based on RBNZ’s projections, the output gap is more negative than expected, estimated to be -1.8% vs. 1.6% seen in May and the narrowing of the output gap is likely to take a longer time. Growth recovery has been weaker than expected with a -0.3% contraction assumed for 2Q. Cooling price pressure and significant spare capacity were key reasons for those who voted for a larger reduction in the OCR. There is concern that the impact of global policy uncertainty on domestic demand could be self-reinforcing and more persistent. A larger reduction in the OCR may generate a clearer signal to support consumption and investment that a smaller reduction may not be able to provide. Still, the vote went to a 25bps cut in the end.

“Key Rate is No Longer Restrictive”

RBNZ has lowered its average OCR projection to 2.55% by 1Q 2026 vs. the trough of 2.85% seen in the May MPS. The “Orr era” of bold decisions still linger given that a 50bps cut was even considered. However, Chief Economist Conway noted that the key rate is “not restrictive” anymore and Hawkesby also cautioned that RBNZ has done enough of rapid policy easing and could “start feeling our way”. In addition, Assistant Governor Karen Silk also noted that the central bank is investigating into the slow transmission of the monetary policy easing thus far. This could suggest that the new few cuts may not come in succession and highly dependent on data. RBNZ may want to pause in Oct before another 25bps cut in Nov and then a final one to take it to the trough of 2.50% in Feb. In addition, the statement did see emphasize on the “upside and downside risks to around the central projections being broadly balanced”. There is also an alternative scenario that “economic recovery could accelerate as the full effects of interest rate reductions flow through the economy”.

NZDUSD Reaction

NZDUSD fell right after the decision was out, breaking below the key 0.5850-support level and was last seen around 0.5820. Next support is seen around 0.5770 before 0.5720. Resistance at 0.5950. Eyes are now on the FOMC Minutes release tonight as well as the Powell’s speech on Fri at Jackson Hole that could be the major cue for the greenback. While the RBNZ policy statement was more dovish than expected, there are signs that the central bank may want to slow the pace of easing, that recovery could take hold earlier once cumulative cuts filter through the economy. Further NZDUSD declines could slow and potentially bottom around 0.5700 before making a recovery. **AUDNZD on the other hand is vulnerable to retracement at this point as we see this cross likely priced in peak divergence.**

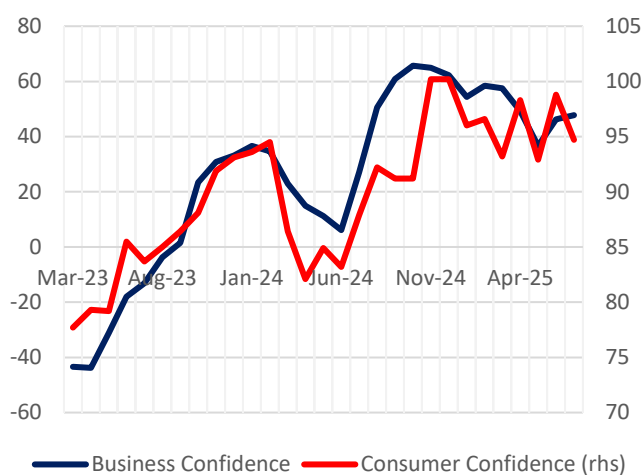

What we got right - The AUDNZD Surge

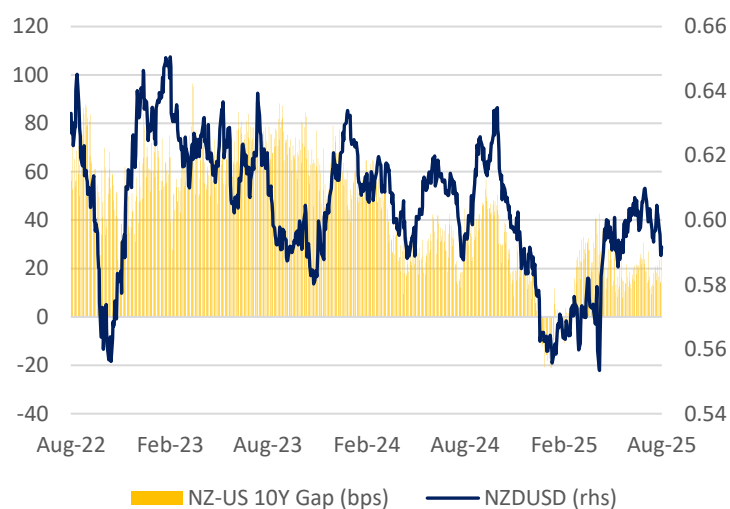
We had looked for AUDNZD to head higher on RBA-RBNZ policy divergence right at the start of the month in our FX monthly. This is in spite of our view for both central banks to cut rates by 25bps each. This is because the Aug cut for RBA was well priced and while we look for RBA to cut for just one more time this cycle, we see risks of a deeper easing cycle for the RBNZ. In our GM daily dated 19 Aug, we had noted “AUDNZD slipped to around 1.0950. We see pullback as tentative and likely to reverse due to RBA-RBNZ policy divergence. This cross can resume range trade but a break out above 1.0975 would open the way towards 1.1050. Our bet is to the upside.” Having said that and with OIS already looking for another 50bps cut to 2.50% by Feb next year, we see room for AUDNZD to retrace lower from current levels around 1.1055 back to levels around 1.0980, 1.0950 and then at 1.0900. Cross has likely priced in peak policy divergence.

Chart 1: Recovery in Consumer, Business Confidence Stalls



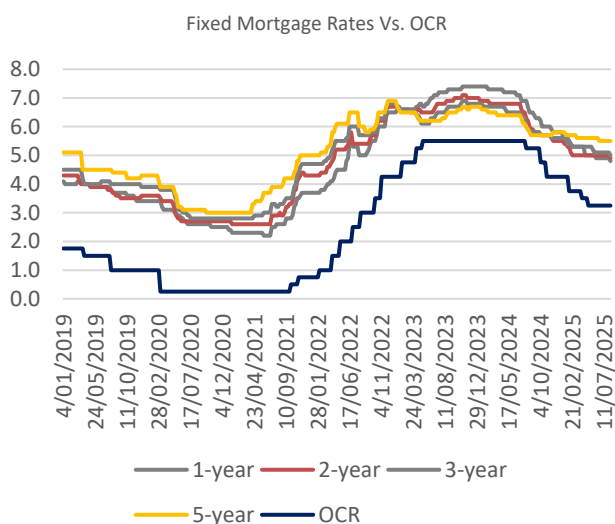

Chart 2: NZ-US Yield Differential Supportive of NZDUSD



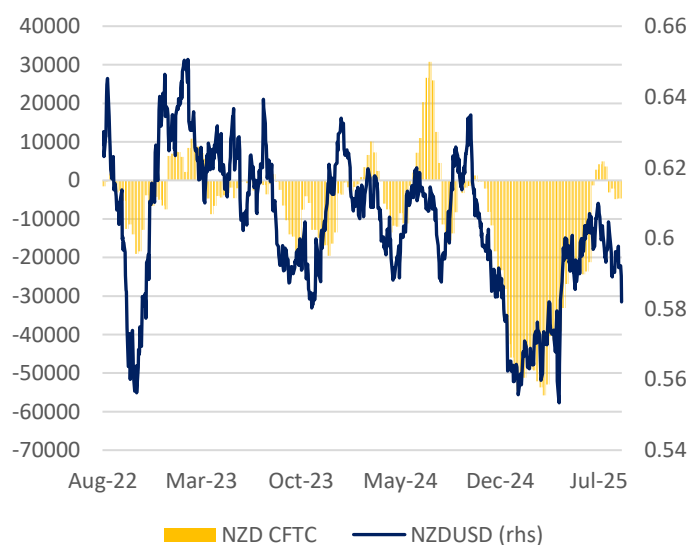

NZDUSD broke below key support level around 0.5850 and was last seen around 0.5820. Momentum indicators are bearish (MACD and Stochastics). Next key support is seen around 0.5770 before the next at 0.5720. Resistance at 0.5950 before the next at 0.6050. With stochastics near oversold conditions, there is a possibility for NZDUSD to bottom around the 0.57-figure. Decline could slow from here. Eyes are on the Fed Minutes tonight, Powell's speech that could provide the next major cue for the USD.
